Intent

At Farnham, it is our intent to deliver a curriculum that will maximise the development of every child's ability creativity in the area of Music. Implementation

- Controlling sounds through singing and playing instruments
- Creating and developing musical ideas
- Responding and reviewing appraising skills
- Listening and applying knowledge and understanding

Children have the opportunity to join the choir and learn to play the recorder and clarinet.

We believe it is important to celebrate and share the achievement of our children. Music in the round is a time where children, staff and parents come together to showcase these achievements. The choir also have opportunity to perform at various times throughout the year.

Visiting Musicians are welcomed into school to inspire our pupils and share their musical talents and knowledge.
