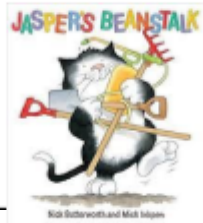


Foundation Stage Newsletter

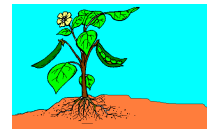
Literacy
