In Science we will be looking at materials. We will look at a range of objects and the materials they are made from. We will describe the properties of everyday materials such as wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock and compare and group them on the basis of their physical processes.

In Art, we will develop our drawing, painting and printing skills to create a window scene inspired by the work of William Morris and Orla Kiely.

Our PSHE focus this half term is all about Healthy Lifestyles and Healthy Minds. We will learn what we can do to keep healthy and that the healthier we are, the less likely we are to be poorly.

In Maths, we will learn about multiplication and division. We will count in 2s, 5s and 10s and recognise equal groups. We will also learn about fractions and find halves and quarters of objects, shapes or quantities.
