How to support maths at home:

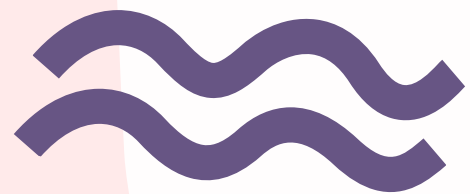
- Support children with their maths passport targets.
