Dear Parents and Carers,

Your child will be taking part in the KS2 National Tests (SATs) w/c Monday 13th May 2024. These assessments will be in Maths and English and will be your child's opportunity to show what they have learned throughout Key Stage 2. It is important that your child arrives <u>before 8:30am</u> and is <u>not absent</u> on these days.

Pupils have been working exceptionally hard in preparation and there are steps you can follow to ensure your child performs as well as they possibly can throughout the test week.

- Check that your child continues to complete revision in the evenings and over the weekend. Practice materials have been provided.
- Make sure your child goes to bed at a reasonable time, gets enough rest and has a healthy diet, particularly breakfast.
- Most importantly, encourage your child to try their very best. They have worked extremely hard this year and
 we want them to finish their time at Farnham with the academic achievements they deserve.

The timetable is as follows:

Monday 13 th May	English Grammar, Punctuation and spelling test (60 minutes)
Tuesday 14 th May	Reading Comprehension test (60 minutes)
Wednesday 15 th May	Mathematics paper 1: arithmetic (30 minutes) Mathematics paper 2: reasoning (40 minutes)
Thursday 16 th May	Mathematics paper 3: reasoning (40 minutes)

The outcomes of the assessments will be reported to you through your child's end of year report.

During test week, pupils are invited to come into school from <u>8.00 am</u> to have breakfast with their friends and staff. Brioche, bagels and drinks will be provided. Your child must be here by <u>8.30am</u> at the latest.
