In Science we are learning about Animals including Humans.

We will be:

- Learning that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.
- Finding out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air)
- Learning about the the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

In Maths, we will be:

- Recognising the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens, ones) within 100.
- Recognising values of 10s and 1s on a number line to 100
- Reading and writing numbers to at least 100 in numerals.
- Partitioning numbers σ 100.
