




This week has been all about the number 5. We went into the nature garden fo find lots of different representations of 5.

















Reception have been reading a new story called Splash Anna Hibiscus. We have acted out going to the beach and talked about how we could make Anna feel better.

In maths, we have been learning about the numbers 9 and 10! We used the magic bag and sorted different arrangements of these numbers,




















Year 1 have enjoyed exploring plants in science. We identified the stem, leaves, petals and roots of different types of plants.


In English we completed our fact files on sloths. In maths we have been learning about height, length and how to measure accurately with a ruler.
















Year 2 have loved starting our new unit in maths on measure! They have understood what height and length means and have practised drawing lines of different lengths.

In English we are looking at the Great Fire of London and planning to deliver a news report based on this.














In maths, we have been learning how to add and subtract lengths. We have also started to learn about perimeter which is the distance around the outside of a closed shape.

In writing, we have been learning the story 'Ellen's Dragon' using actions to help us. We are looking forward to writing our own innovated versions of this story next week.


In science, we have been learning all about how water travels through a plant. We set up an investigation using celery and food colouring to help us visualize the process. We have observed the change over the week.

















In maths, we have continued our learning of fractions and began to look at equivalent fractions on a number line.
