


counters and a 10s frame to help us.




Year 1

In science we have been learning about garden flowers and wild flowers and sorting them into the correct groups.






In English we have been busy looking at News Reports and writing our own based on the Great Fire of London.

In maths, we have been learning about fractions and how different denominators affect the share of the pizza you get.


In computing, we have been using the Keynote app to create digital art. We know how to change the opacity of the picture and add colour. We hope to take part in David Hockney's Draw competition.

In writing, we have been thinking about performing our stories for others to listen to. We practised reading them using our fluency skills and then recorded our work.


In maths, we have started to look at how to draw, read and interpret line graphs and tables.
