Oliver doesn't eat vegetables but eats chips.


We found out that chips come from potatoes and a potato

Mrs Lilley peeled the potatoes and cut them into chips.


We ate them for our snack.

In maths, we have been learning all about doubling and odd and even numbers. We used numicon to help us.


In literacy, we have put the story of Somebody Swallowed Stanley into the correct order.


In PSED, we have made a respectful circle. We discussed ways we can show respect to others at school and at home.














In maths we have been learning all about how to measure and compare capacity. We used cubes and different containers to measure and record this,

In science we have been looking at signs of spring. We went on a walk around school and the nature garden to find lots of different things.






In maths we have been learning about different aspects of measure.

#### **Science**


We investigated which substances were soluble and would dissolve in solutions.
