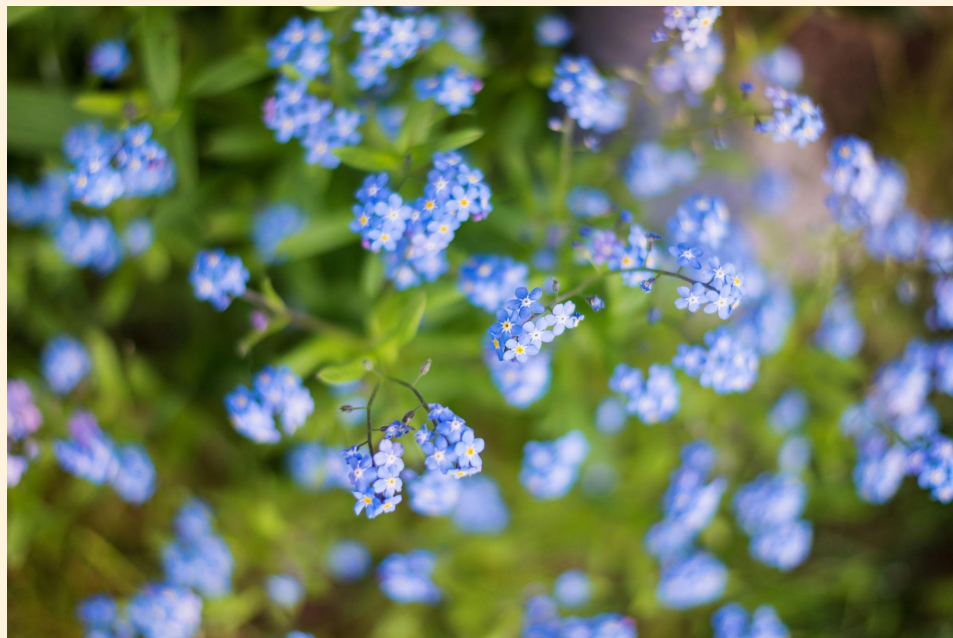

On our first week back we visited the nature garden. We looked for flowers. We also looked at what the flowers were growing in, soil.



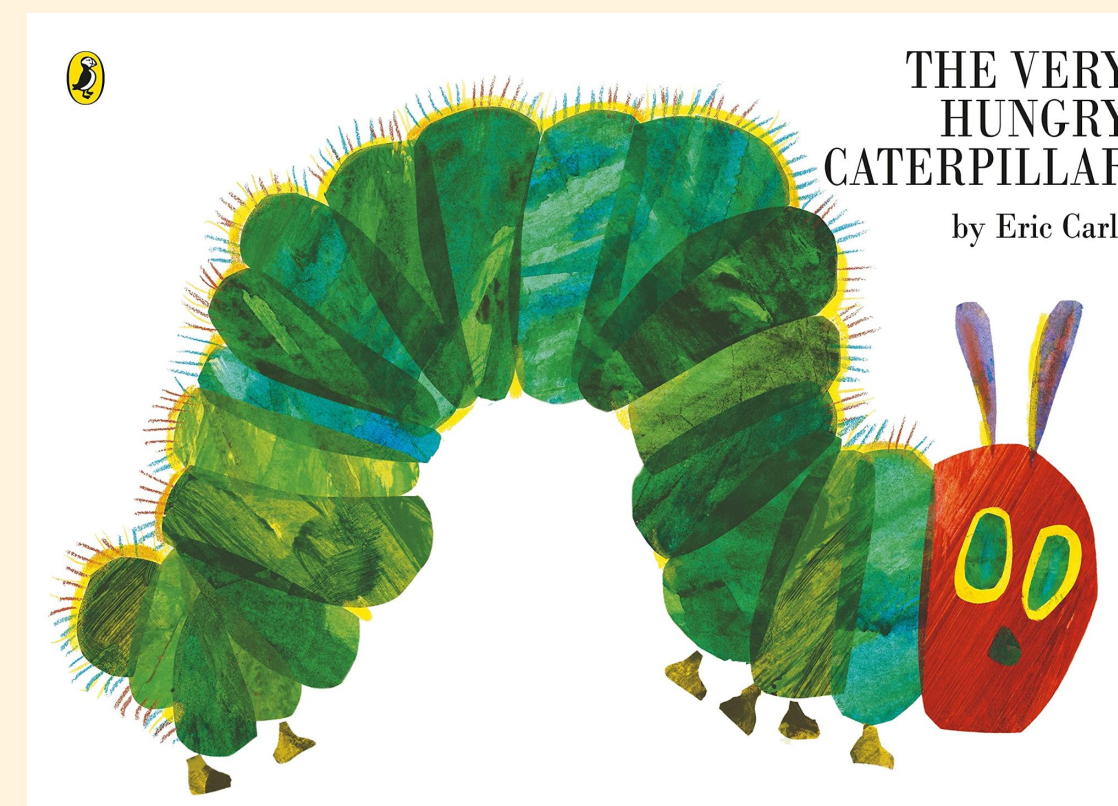
Reception

Literacy

We had a wonderful visit to Harlow Carr on Wednesday. We spent time exploring the different plants in the grounds, learning how seeds grow and we planted our own seeds.

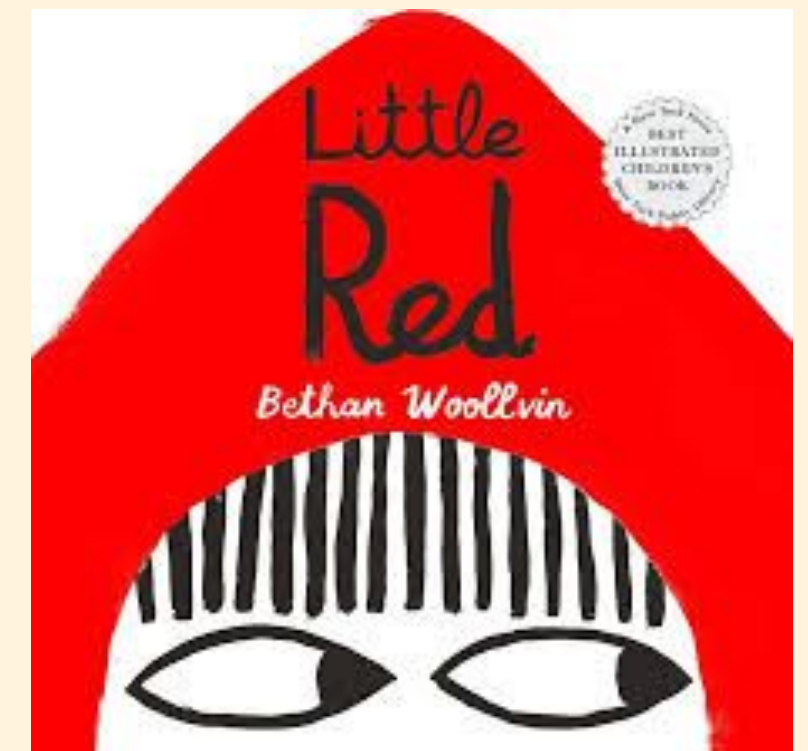


Year 2

In computing, we discussed how too much screen time can affect our health.

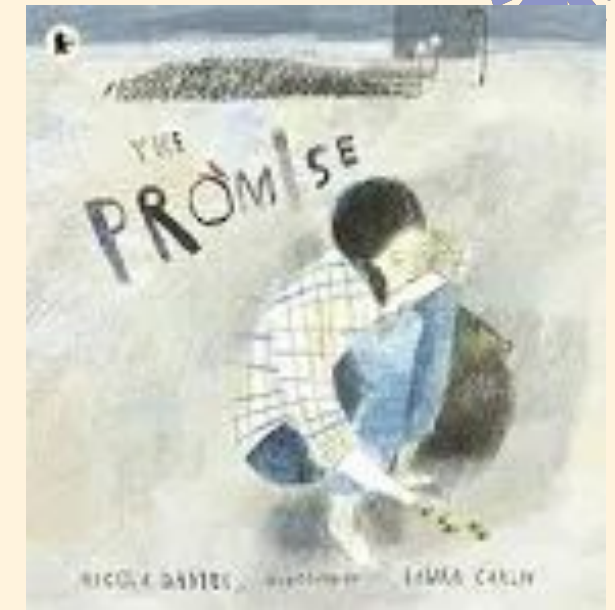
We came up with ways to help reduce our online time. These included:
