





Reception



She devises a clever plan to stop them, and with the help of the other animals, they save the cow. In maths we have been learning all about making equal groups. We did this by grouping and sharing different objects.

In science we have been identifying different birds by writing key features about them.










In writing, we have started gathering ideas on

### Reading



### Art



### Writing


In writing we have been working on writing a flashback from Father's point of view, of the story The Arrival.
