# Reception

In literacy, we explored the story *What the Ladybird Heard* by Julia Donaldson. Inspired by the story, we created "Wanted" posters for the characters Lanky Len and Hefty Hugh, practicing their writing and drawing skills.

In maths, we focused on addition. The children had a great time making a bus outside and adding children onto it, reinforcing their understanding of counting and simple addition. Looking forward to another week of learning and fun!





# Year 1

In English we have been playing lots of phonics games to help us with our reading.

In maths, we have been finding half of a quantity.

We have been drawing still life pictures inspired by David Hockney and have some great entries to put forward to the Being Hockney competition.



# Year 2

In English we have been looking at the genre of our new writing. We have explored what a persuasive advert includes and tried writing our own sentences.

In maths we have been learning how to find  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a number.

We have looked at woodland habitats in science and researched which animals live there. We found out their diet, habitat and any predators they might have!

**Habitat:** woodland, farmland, upland, urban

**Diet:** rabbits, rodents, birds, invertebrates, fruit and berries

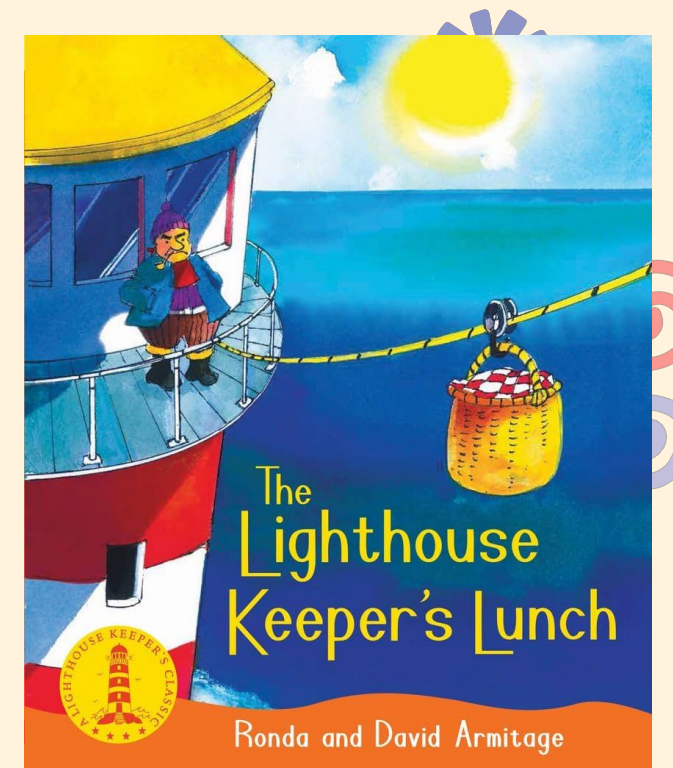
**Predators:** adults have no natural predators in the UK.



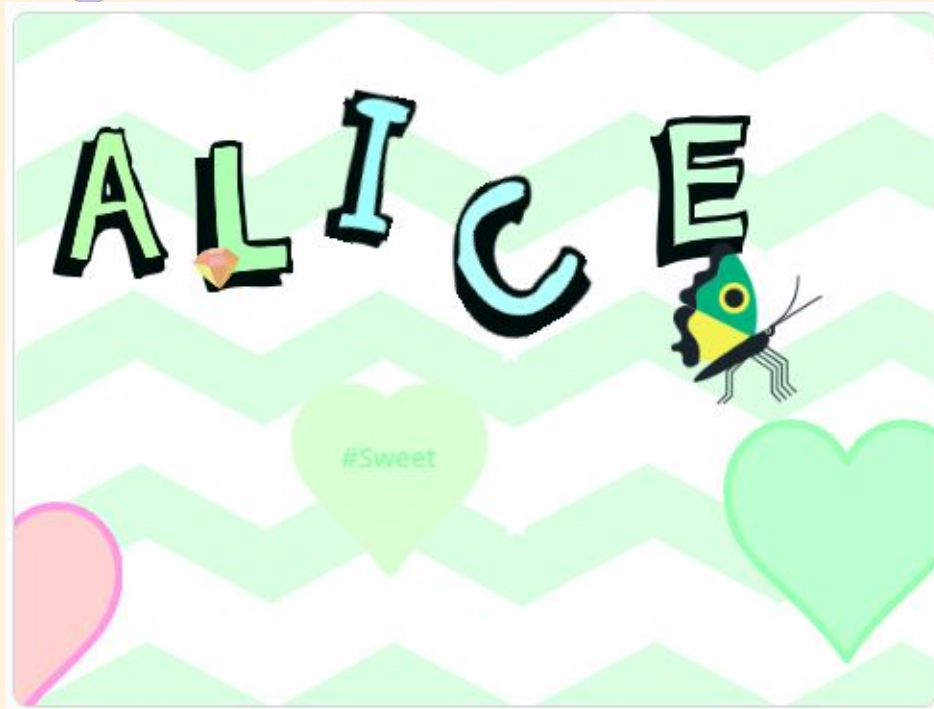


# Year 3
