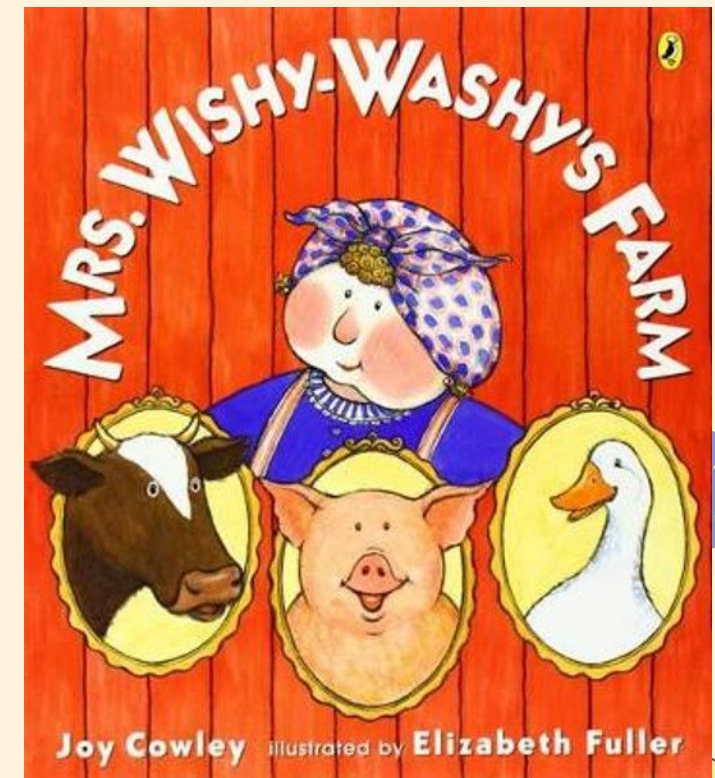

In **PSED**, we started talking about moving into our new classes. We shared how we're feeling about the change and supported each other by talking about the exciting things ahead.

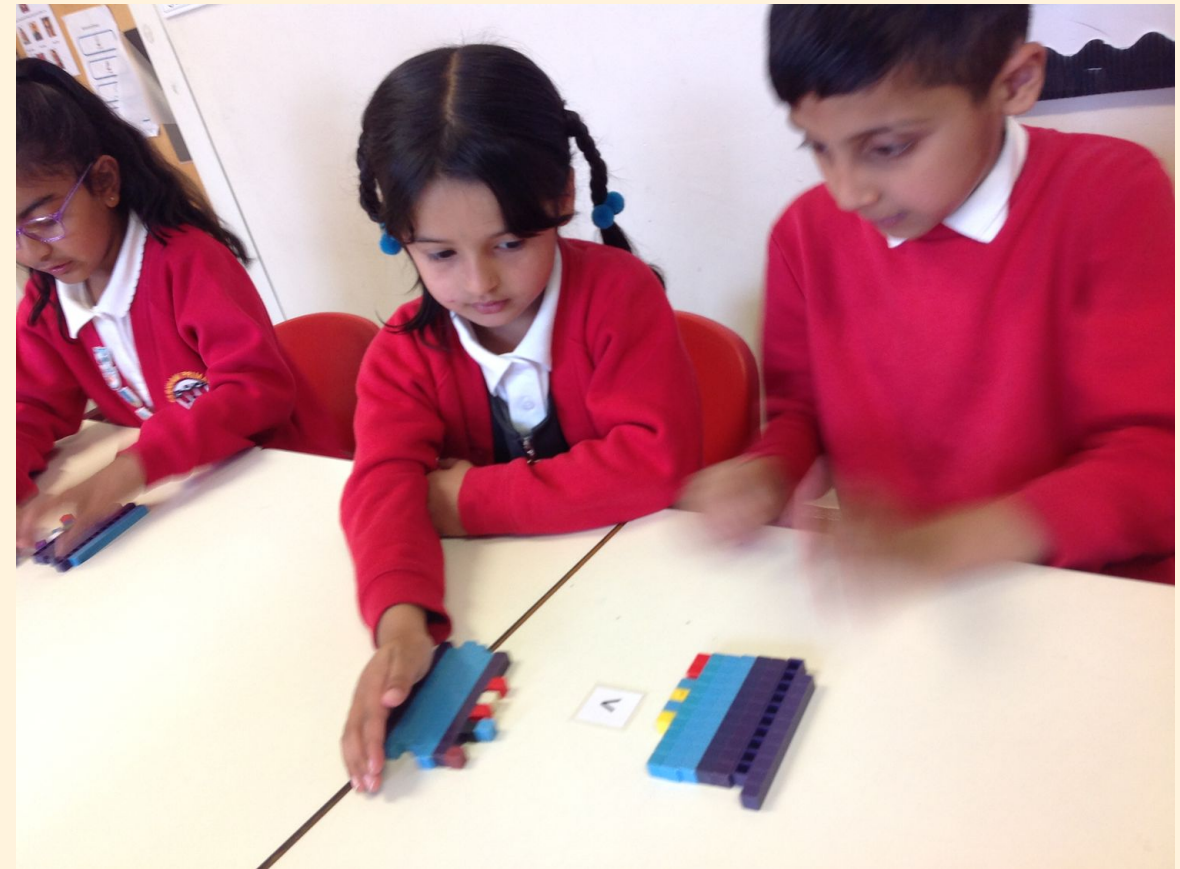


Year 1

In science we have been learning about what special events happen in different seasons.

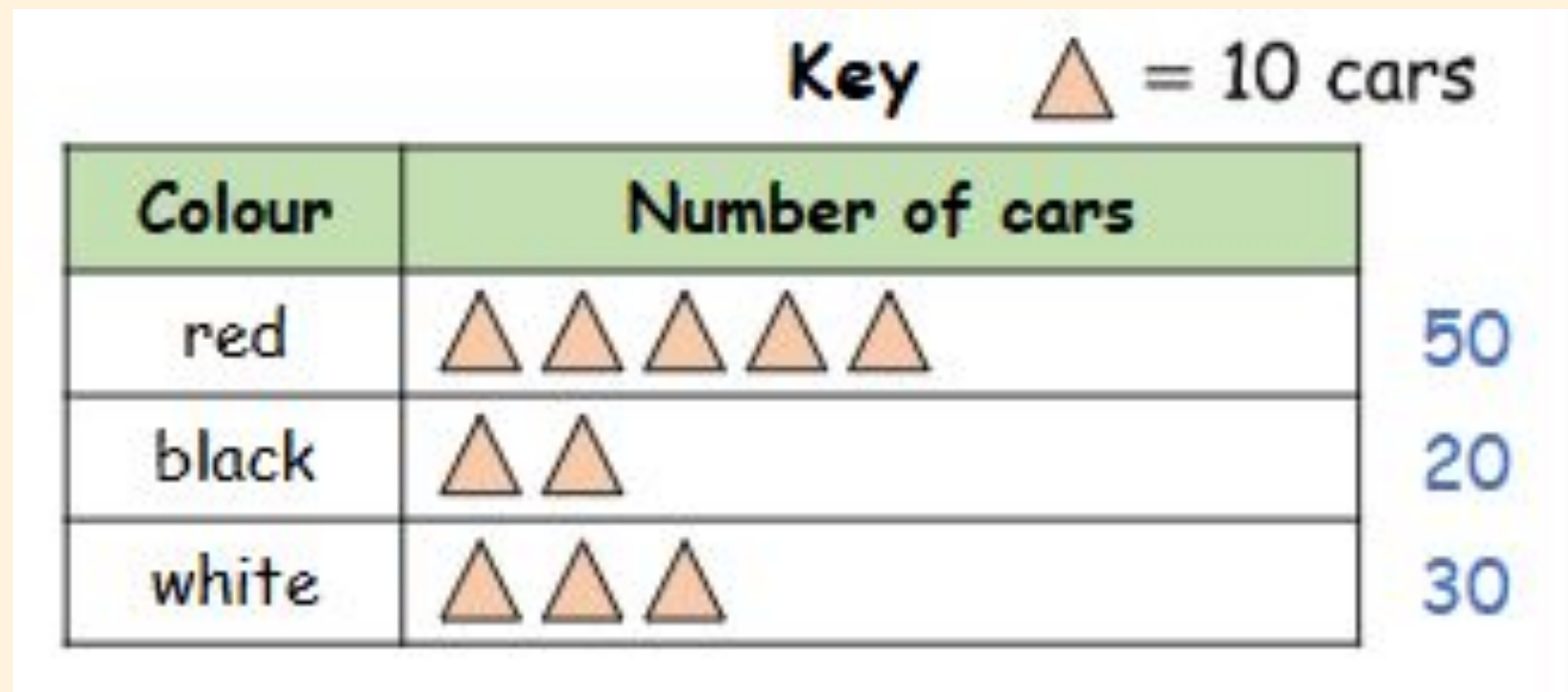


Year 2

In reading, we have written our own ghost stories and read them to each other. We really enjoyed using spooky words with glitter highlights.

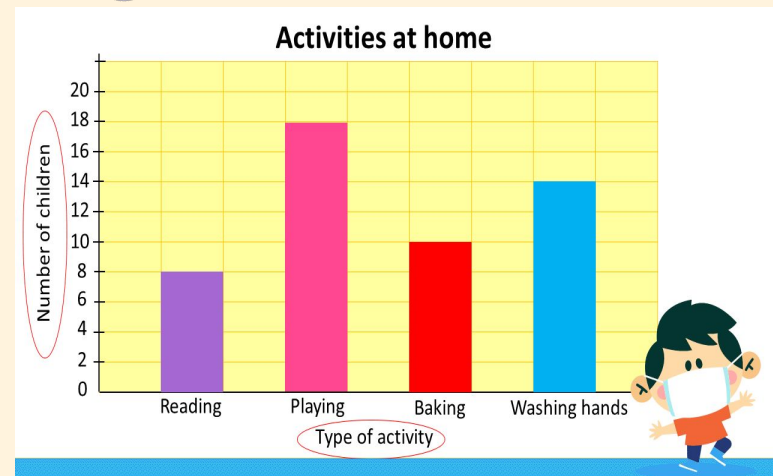
In maths, we have been learning how to tell the time with minutes to the hour and past.
