What we're learning next half term

English

We will be writing a variety of genres based on a movie trailer this term. We will look at consolidating our Year 3 learning of fronted adverbials, commas in a list and speech.

Maths

This term, we will be learning about time, including Roman numerals. We will also focus on recalling 2D shapes and learning 3D shapes in order to have a chance at getting onto a NASA passport.

Geography

We will be taking a deeper look at our local area on an ordnance survey map and understanding how we are placed in a city within a county. We will be walking around the local area and mapping what we see.

Science

Does hand span affect grip strength? We will be planning an experiment to test a hypothesis by, analysing data, evaluating and presenting our results.
