






# Farnham School News

We used binoculars to see what we could see.


Maha could see the trees outside the window.

Siyana saw the home corner and Ibrahim could see Mrs lilley.










## Reception





In art we have been making sculptures inspired by the artist Samantha Stephenson. We used paper to make our own sculptures.














In maths we have been looking at positions and directions. We have been trying to figure out how to get from one place to another using directional language.




In English we have been editing our first person recounts of a girl finding some bubbles and going on an adventure.

In our geography lesson, we have been exploring the Amazon Rainforest. This week, we focused on the dangers to the Amazon and what we can do to protect it.











Year 5 have looked at the life cycle of an amphibian in Science, particularly a frog!

We have continued to work on our web page design in computing sharing our learning of deserts in Geography. Here is an example!


















This week have been rehearsing our leaver assembly and songs. It already sounds fantastic!
