



In maths this week we have been learning about the order which numbers come in, looking for the next number. We have used numbered cars, we learnt that number 2 comes after number 1.








Reception

In literacy, we began reading *The Leopard's Drum*—the children really enjoyed predicting what might happen in the story just by looking at the front cover, and we even had a go using a drum to bring the story to life.

In maths, we used Numicon to recap our number bonds to 10, and the children had great fun exploring the different combinations.

In PSED, we talked about our achievements and what makes us feel proud; each child then wrote their own achievement on a rosette.



In English we have been writing diaries. We wrote about what we did each day and we remembered to use a capital letter for the days of the week.

In maths we have been learning about time. We looked at whether activities take hours, minutes or seconds to complete and have learnt to tell the time to o'clock and half past.


In art, we continued to use paper to create sculptures. This week we experimented with lots of different ways to fold and shape paper.




Year 2 In writing we have continued looking at Hortense and the Shadow and writing what we think she should say to her shadow.

In maths, we have started a new unit all about position and direction. We have been writing and plotting coordinates.


In our geography lesson, we have been exploring the Amazon Rainforest. This week, we focused on the dangers to the Amazon and what we can do to protect it.
