







# Nursery



# Year 1

In maths, we have been practising subtraction with numbers up to 10. We have also been representing numbers in different ways.



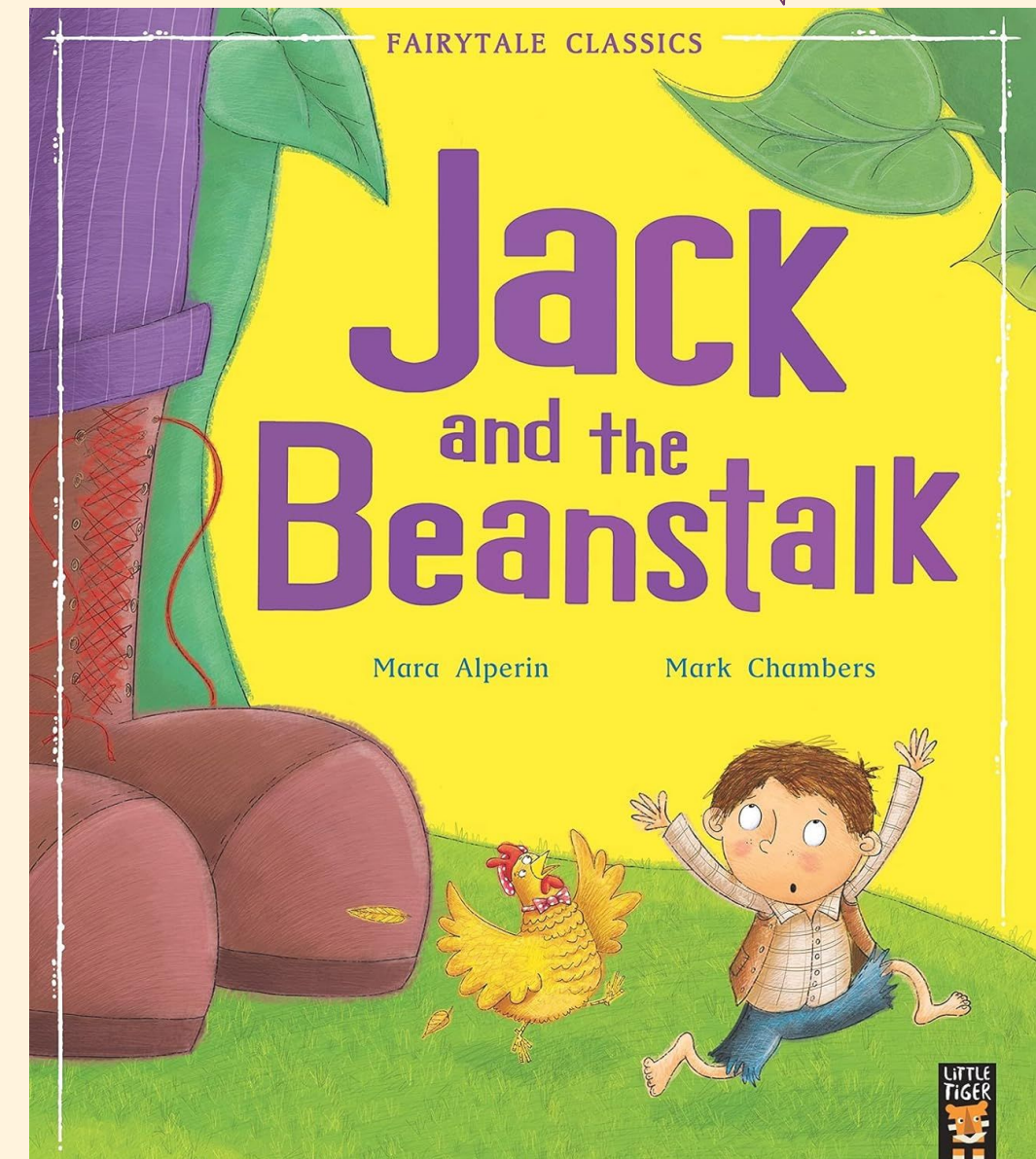


# Year 2

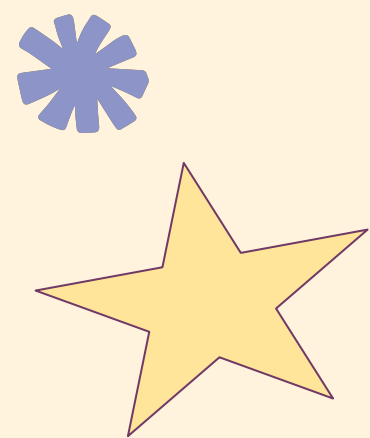
Year 2 have started to read their new story, Jack and the Beanstalk. We made predictions, talked about other our favourite fairy tales and gave Jack some good advice!

In science we explored the school grounds looking for things that were living, non-living and had never been alive.

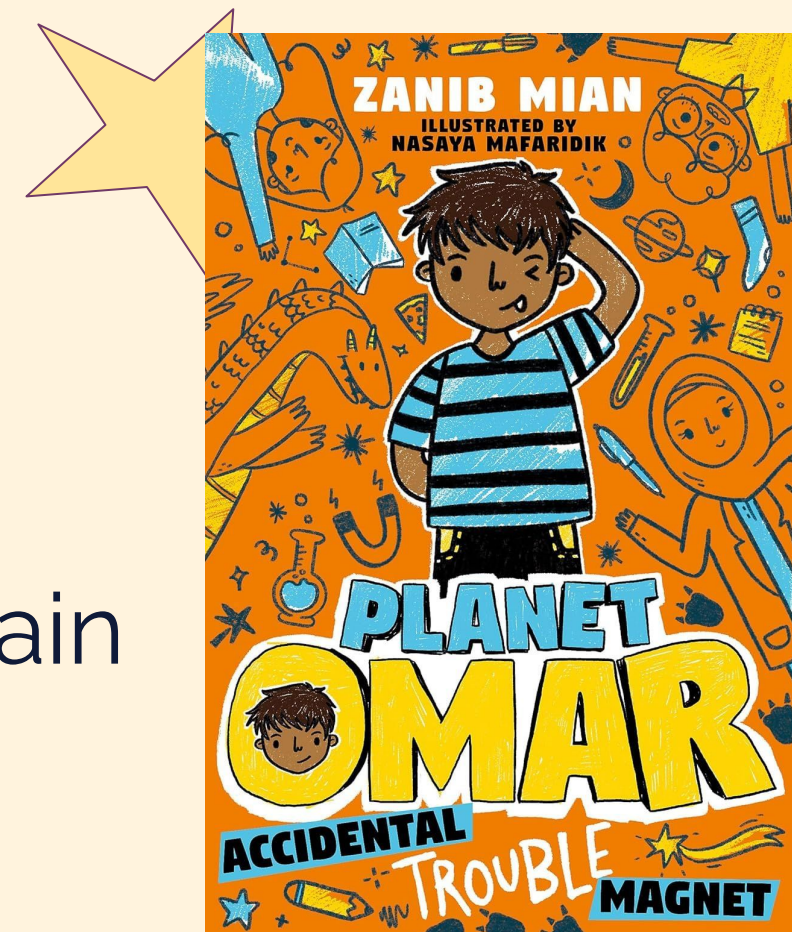
In maths we learned about place value and counting larger groups of objects in 10s.







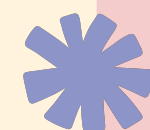
# Year 3

We had our very first French lesson this week, we are super excited to learn more French as the year goes on.

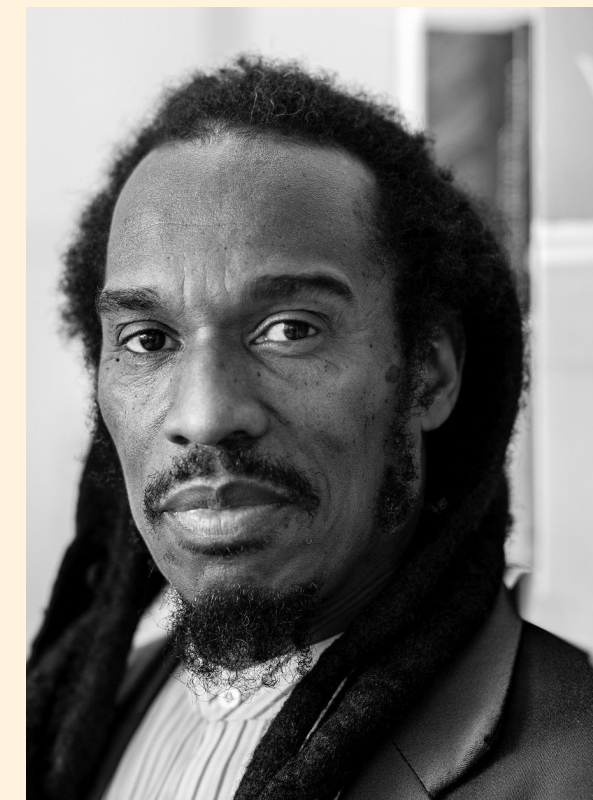
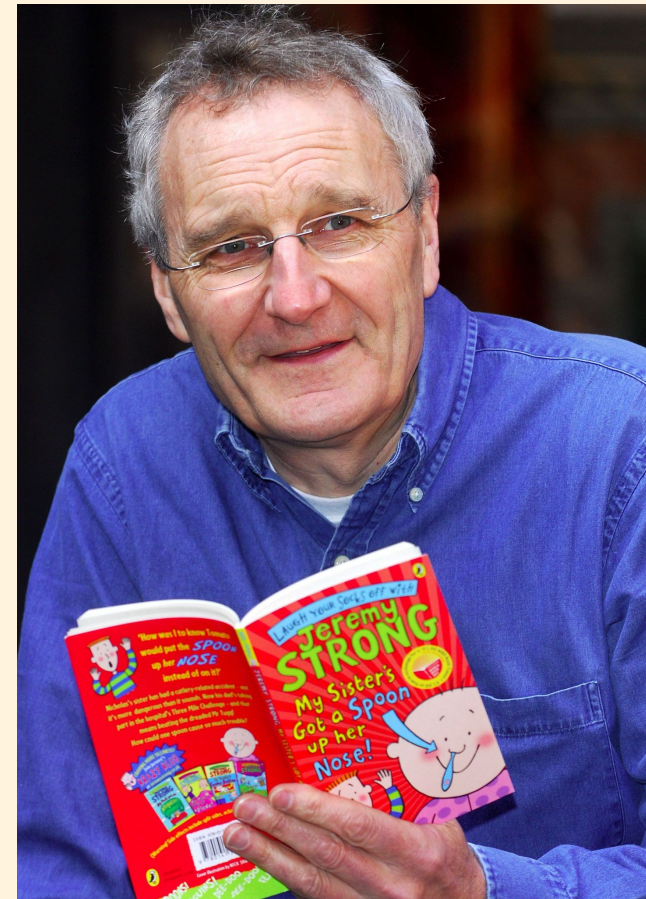




# Year 4
