In maths, we have continued to represent numbers to 10 in different ways and have explored number patterns.






Year 2 have been looking at different adjectives to describe the giant and write sentences about him.

In history we have been learning about Farnham Primary School in the past. We asked Ms Sattar and Mrs Dorat what life was like at Farnham when they went to school here!


In maths we have been revisiting our learning and recapping our number bonds to 10!




















In writing, we have continued to recap our prior learning. We went on a 'noun hunt' around school. We then sorted these into common nouns and proper nouns.


In history, we have been learning about Skara Brae and what this tells us about life in the Stone Age.

In science, we have started to learn about our skeleton, its functions and the different bones and types of joints in our bodies.










In year 4 we have been working hard to understand place value. We have been practicing the skills of 10/100 more and 10/100 less.

On Wednesday, some of our classmates went to Nell Bank for a residential. We can't wait to hear all about their visit.








10, 100 and 1000.
