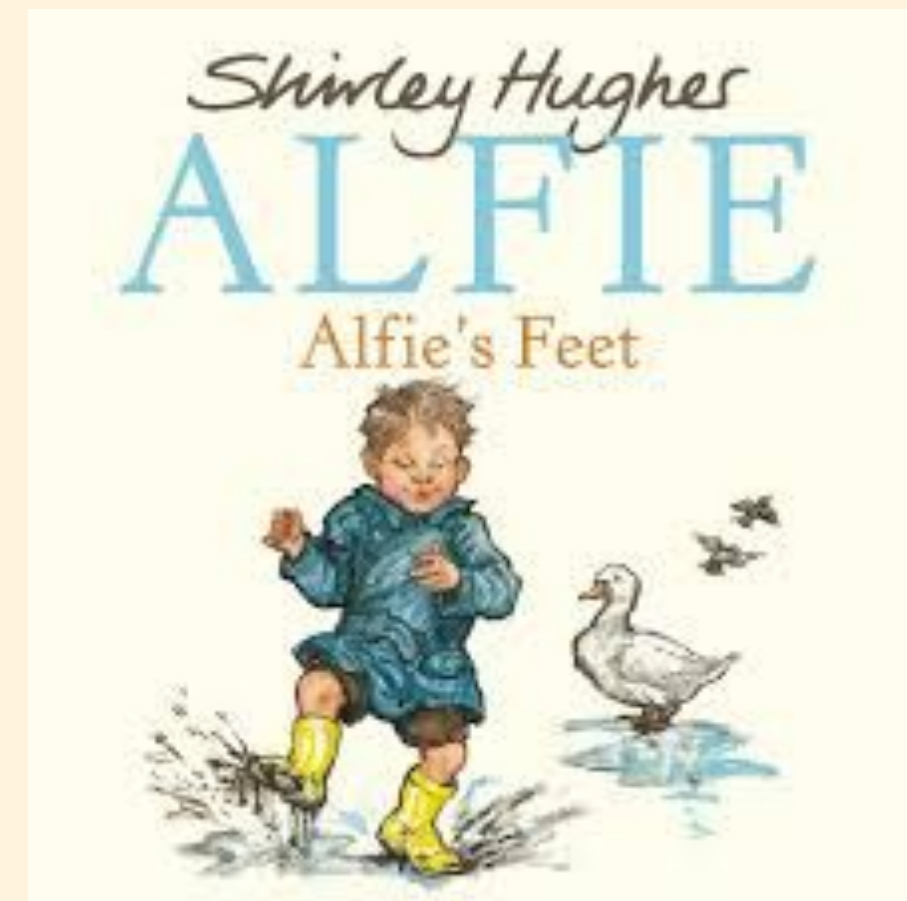

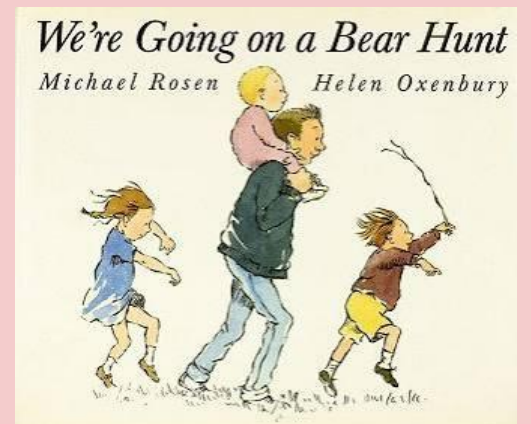
Nursery

Reception

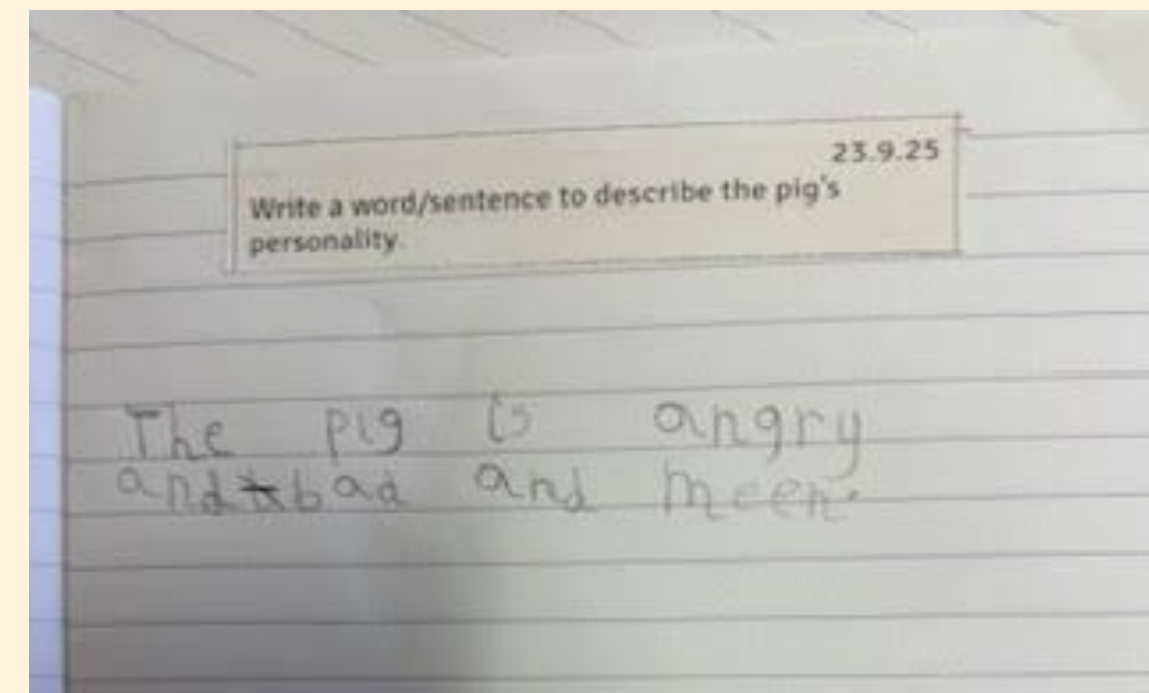
This week in class, we've been busy exploring lots of exciting learning! In maths, we have been sorting different objects and finding out how they can be grouped. We also had fun acting out the story *We're Going on a Bear Hunt*. Alongside this, we've been learning more about where we live and discovering new things about Bradford.



Year 1

In science, we have been learning about trees change across the four seasons. We represented the seasonal changes by finger painting. We had lots of fun!

In English, we have completed a role on the wall to describe the big, bad pig. We then used this to write words, captions or sentences.



Year 2

In English, we have been practising using full stops and capital letters. We have also been using our imagination and our artistic skills to create the land at the top of the beanstalk.



In maths, we have been finding out about fact families to 20 and working out related number facts for example $1+9=10$ and $10+90=100$.

In science we have continued our work on habitats, sorting plants and animals as to whether they live in the ocean or coastal, woodland, rainforest areas.

In English we have been asking questions to Orion to find out more about the story Orion and the Dark.

In maths we have had fun partitioning numbers up to 1000 using place value counters and base ten equipment.

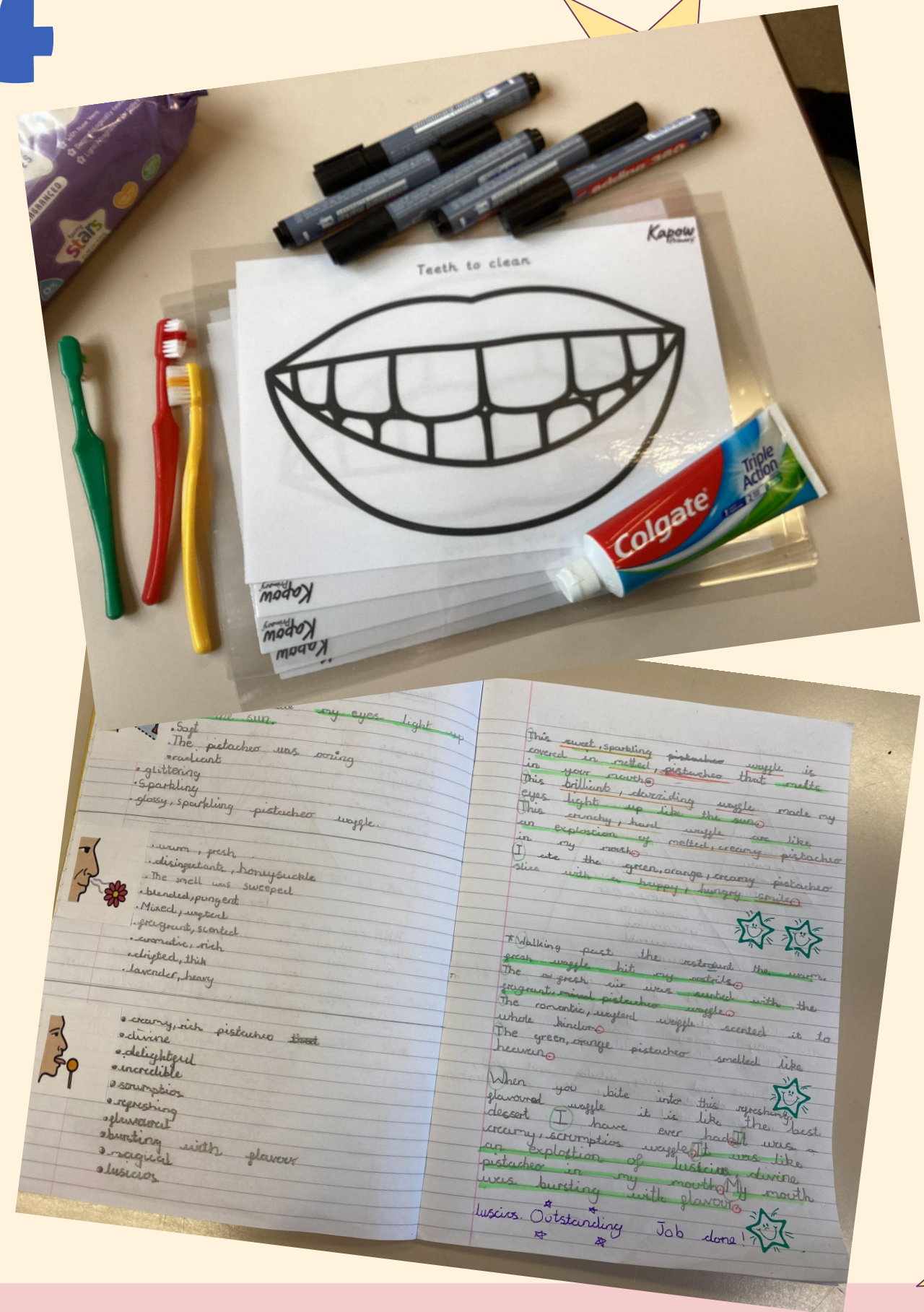
We brought our history learning to life by using the Now Press Play headsets to explore what life was like in the stone age period. We hunted and killed a woolly mammoth!

We have been writing a description of a dessert inspired by our book, 'The Cafe on the edge of the Woods.'



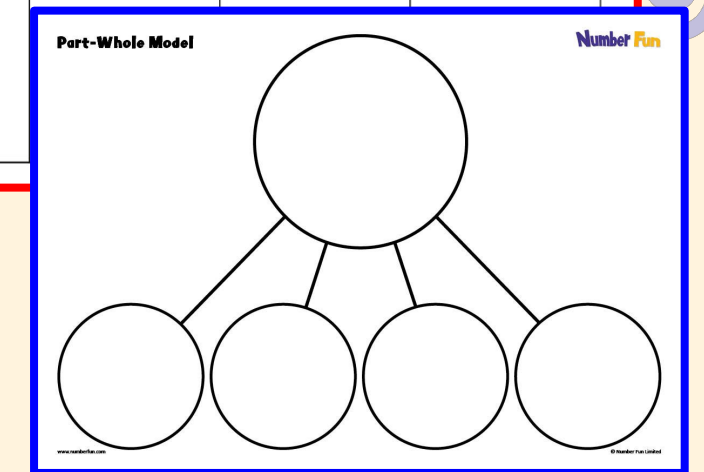
Year 5

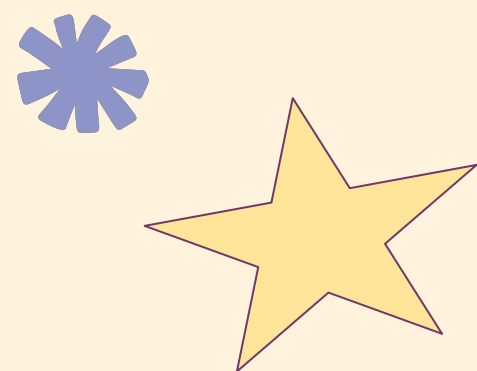

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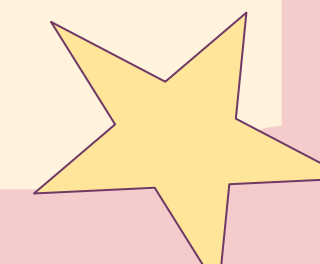
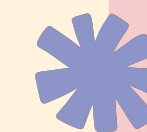
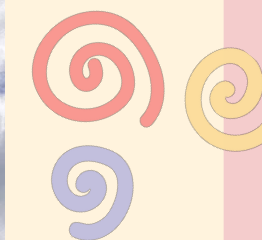
Year 6
