School days and times

The school day starts at 8.40am and finishes at

3.10pm. Please make sure that you arrive on time.

School adults will be in the playground from

8.35am to greet your children. To develop their independence, please say goodbye to the children in the top playground and allow children to walk to their class teacher in the bottom playground.

Reception children enter through the Reception classroom doors.

We always want to make sure that every child at Farnham is looked after in the best possible way. Research shows that high quality education can influence how well a child does at school and we want to access any additional funding which may help families attending Farnham.

We will use any funding to improve the quality of education that we provide for your child. This includes supporting families with the cost of school meals, uniform and educational visits.

Our admin team in the school office are happy to support you to check if your child is eligible for pupil premium funding.

Important Information for ALL Year 3 Parents - PLEASE READ!

Universal infant free school meals (UIFSM) provides funding from the government for us to offer free school meals to ALL pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.

Once your child moves to Year 3, school meals are chargeable unless your child receives Pupil Premium funding. We want to support our families as much as possible and wherever possible, we would like all of our pupils to eat a warm, wholesome meal at lunchtime therefore if you think your child is eligible for Pupil Premium funding, please speak to a member of our office team who can check this for you.



### **Educational visits**

We are busy organising educational visits and visitors for our pupils to give them new experiences and enhance their learning.

Following feedback from parents, we will be asking for a smaller voluntary contribution for each educational visit throughout the school year rather than one large contribution at the start of the year. Please be aware that should we not receive enough voluntary contributions, a trip may be cancelled.

School uniform

All children should wear school uniforms at all times. Families who are eligible for Pupil Premium funding can receive support with uniforms.

Uniforms can be easily purchased from supermarkets such as Asda, Tesco, Primark etc or if you wish to buy jumpers and polo shirts with the school logo, they can be purchased from Natasha's or Academia uniform shops.

Our school uniform is:

- White polo shirt (optional with logo)
- Red, round neck sweatshirt or cardigan (optional with logo)
- Grey trousers, skirt, pinafore dress or shalwar kameez
- Black shoes
- In summer, pupils can wear grey tailored shorts or a red checked summer dress.

#### PF

Class teachers will share information about PE days using the Marvellous Me app.

PE kit (to be worn to school on PE days)

- Plain, white, round next t-shirt
- Pair of black shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms
- Plain, black, zipped hoodie or sweatshirt
- Plain black trainers
- Pupils will need a pair of black pumps in a red drawstring bag (for

indoor PE lessons that will be kept in school)

To keep pupils safe, we respectfully ask that headscarves are secured with a clip or safety pin on PE days rather than a simple pin as these can become loose during physical activity.

It is essential that all school clothing, PE clothing, pump bags and footwear are marked with your child's name.

Please ensure your child's hairstyle is sensible and appropriate. No fash ion stylings, patterns



or colours please. Long hair should be tied back and children should not wear jewellery when they have PE lessons.

We are excited to share the news that using the proceeds we have raised through our fairs and parties, we have had two new amazing sand pits built over the summer holiday.


One is in our early years playground and will be used by pupils in nursery, reception and some of our SEND pupils.
