The additional words and sets (in black) either reinforce the rule/pattern being taught; practise a spelling rule linked to a Y2 statutory requirement or practise the common exception words (with an asterisk). Each set of spellings contains 10 words linked to the objective. Please note, the following words are included because of their pronunciation with a Southern accent: nothing, after\*, past\*, fast\*, last\*, father\*, class\*, grass\*, pass\*, plant\*, path\*, bath\*.
