



Reception



This week in Reception, we have been busy decorating pumpkins and talking about what we see during Halloween. In English, we have


been reading and acting out The Three Billy Goats Gruff. During provision time, the children have enjoyed using loose parts to create

different structures.








In art we created a clay tile and painted it, based on our history learning about the Victorians.






In maths, we have persevered when learning the written column method for addition. We were so proud of ourselves for our beautiful presentation.

We had so much fun on the first TTRockstars day! We are excited to carry on learning all of our timetables using games and activities to help us.






