What we're learning this half term

English

In reading we will be reading a book by Michael Rosen called Uncle Gobb and The Dread Shed. We will also be learning some of his poems. In writing, we will be using digital literacy to inspire our own character and setting descriptions.

Maths

We will continue our addition and subtraction topic before moving on to multiplication and division.

Geography

We will be investigating 'Why do some people live in volcanic areas?'. We will discover what causes volcanoes, parts of a volcano, where volcanic eruptions are likely to occur and the positives and negatives of living in a volcanic area.

French

We will be learning all about how to read, write and say the names of different animals in French.
