

This week in Maths, we have been learning about one more. The counting puppet helped us practise counting carefully and successfully.




We also explored the celebration of Diwali and enjoyed decorating colourful diya lamps.

In provision, we have been busy practising number formation and learning the names of different shapes.








This week in English we enjoyed going on our 'lets say' journey through the forest where we were looking for the beast from our story.

them to create Rangoli Patterns.
















We have really impressed Miss Turner and Mrs Kirwin with our geography learning so far this half term. We know so many interesting facts about the layers of the earth.

In geography, we have been learning all about the different layers of the rainforest and we produced some fantastic mini books with drawings and information on each layer.









In writing, we have started to write our own poems about the planet Mars. We are trying to use personification, metaphors and similes


We have been on a mission in maths to find the secrets of numbers, through exploration. We have enjoyed taking control of our learning journeys.












In geography this week, we have looked at the route we are taking on our school trip to St Ives! We have looked at the coordinates of our data collection points.
