


Reception


Year 1

In maths, we have been continuing learning about shapes. We have used our shape knowledge to create a repeat pattern to create our own Christmas wrapping paper!




Year 2




 In English we have been writing and publishing our pieces of work on how to look after a pet.

In geography we summed up our learning and answered the question 'would we like to live in a hot or cold place'




Year 3

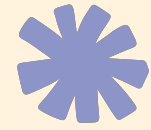

In geography, we looked at reasons why some people live near volcanoes even though they can be dangerous.








Year 4

In geography we have created an action plan to help the school become more sustainable.



In writing we have been using time conjunctions to write instructions for the perfect hot chocolate.

In reading, we have got to the part of the story where Varjak meets a dog and returns home. We are going to read the ending today and can't wait to find out what happens.




Year 6
