

# Nursery




Wednesday afternoon.




# Reception



# Year 1






In maths, we have continued our learning of teen numbers and have worked really hard to form the numbers correctly and spell the number name.

In maths we have been finishing off our learning on money, looking at notes and comparing amounts.


In science we have been learning about different materials. We have looked at why they are suitable for a particular use.

In writing, we are starting to write our formal letter to Professor Browntone - we hope that we are chosen to visit his vault!









In art, we have enjoyed sketching different sweet wrappers and have looked at the shadows on each one.
