What we're learning this half term

English

In English, we are going to read an alternative version of Rapunzel. We will be writing diary entries in role and explaining how she feels about being locked in the tower.

Maths

In maths we will be looking at units on money and multiplication. We will review our learning on the 2, 5 and 10 times tables as well as recognising and adding together amounts of money.

History

In history our learning is based around finding out 'How did we learn to fly?' We will look at famous people such as Emilia Earhart and the Wright brothers and find out how they helped shape aviation today.

Science

We will be learning all about materials this half term. We will find out the names of different materials, their uses and what properties they have which makes them suitable for that use. We will also experiment with how twisting, squeezing, bending and squashing can change the shape of a material.

PSHE

Our Story Project learning this half term will be based on a book called 'Chicken Clicking'. Children will learn about e-safety, how to stay safe online and the dangers of being online.
